DEVIZES - WESTELLNSTER CANOE RACE - EASTER 1964_

Sticky and I left for Devizes in OXO on Thursday night with the cance lashed on top of the van. We started at 8a.m. on Good Friday (having had 4 hours sleep the night before!) along the canal and were followed up by Muff and Stuart in the Bug. The first 35 miles (to Newbury) were hard going since there was no current in the canal and we were going up hill.
